

Ain't nuthin' ordinary about it!

"Hot, ain't it?" During the whole time that I was in seminary...every month, I received a check from the Friendship class of Munholland Memorial UMC for \$100. During those long, steamy, hot, "dog days" of summer, Mr. T.L. Luna would include in the check a simple little note that said, "Hot, ain't it?"

I hardly ever think of the "dog days of summer" without thinking of Mr. Luna, that Sunday School class, that welcomed money and that special connection to all of those people back home.

And, I hardly ever think of the dog days of summer without thinking of growing up in the church in something called "ordinary time." "Ordinary time" was that time on the calendar of the church year, after the season of Pentecost, and before the season of Advent. "Ordinary time" or "Kingdomtide" is framed in the church year by Trinity Sunday and Christ the King Sunday. For us, this year, Trinity Sunday was on May the 22nd and Christ the King Sunday will be on November the 20th. This "ordinary time" represents 26 weeks of our calendar year. This period of time represents about 50% of the Christian year.

Growing up in the church, I received this time in the following way: first, it was summer in New Orleans it was hot and church, although it was church, was a bit boring. There was nothing much happening at this time in the Christian year. Christmas...done and over with...Easter...gone...Pentecost...the fresh breath of the spirit just a bit of day old air... just twenty plus weeks of the (not very) attractive color of green adorning the altar with no special

uuumph!

This year, for example, has been anything but "ordinary." In these weeks since May 22nd I have: received a call to be moved to a new appointment, packed and moved a house, nurture and cared for a mother with pups, unpacked a house and been greeted by a new congregation.

As I have matured in the faith, I have come to understand that there is no "ordinary time" in God's sense of time. We are told that our concept of time calendars...day planners... appointments... watches...schedules...birthdays...are all important as we understand those things as chronos...or chronological time...

But, for Christians...we need to understand time in a different way...we need to understand time as Kairos...not our time...not ordinary time...but God's very own special time...

Kairos is a Greek word that means, essentially, 'this moment in time' or "the right time and the right moment."

Kairos is the time when we cease to exist by calendar and exist only by faith. I am quick to tell bereaving families that, for them, largely time, chronos, has stopped. Surely, days, hours, weeks, months, even years, have passed by...but, in a sense, time, as they know it has stopped for their time has become a faith-filled pilgrimage in the Holy and indescribable presence of God.

My life has been incredibly changed by trying to soak in each moment of time...not as ordinary but as extraordinary...as God's precious, gifted time... in faith.
