

#### ~ Stewardship Moment

On Sunday, June 11th, the Church Conference of Aldersgate United Methodist Church met and unanimously approved two specific proposals regarding our financial situation at Aldersgate United Methodist Church.

The first proposal was to make available \$75,000.00 from the proceeds of the property across Robert Blvd. as a cash reserve for the Operating Budget. The principal reason for this is to create an operating cash reserve of \$75,000 that would provide more than a month of positive cash flow to the operating budget throughout the year. Therefore, it is necessary for the ordinary operation of the church that the church provide a cash reserve for the payment of our expenses, especially during the summer months when giving is down and expenses are up.

#### Having such a cash flow should serve as a layer of protection NOT as a substitute to regular, pledged and unpledged contributions.

**The second proposal** was to move \$75,000.00 from the proceeds of the property across Robert Blvd. to the Trustees Designated Fund as "Undesignated" for use by the Trustees for ongoing maintenance and property repairs. There is substantial deferred maintenance on the property that needs to be addressed by the Board of Trustees. This money would be used as General Trustees monies for the maintenance and capital improvement of Aldersgate United Methodist Church.

While both of these proposals passed, unanimously, there was a great deal of concern voiced and discussed about how we are to grow stewardship in order to support the Operating Budget of the church.

Please continue to be in prayer about your financial giving to the church.
